Parent Instruction-Mystery Bag

Materials: A bag with familiar but surprising objects inside which will fit in the child's

hand. These should represent a variety of textures and materials (such as a rock, walnut, thimble, key, candle, fir cone, rope, top of a jar, cotton, yarn, seed pod, paper clip, rubber band, etc.) Have about ten objects at a time and change them

from time to time to maintain interest.

Purposes: To refine the stereognostic perception

Development of the ability to visualize mentally

Steps:

1. Invite your child to work with the Mystery Bag at a table or rug.

- 2. Sit by his right side if you are right-handed or by his left side if you are left-handed.
- 3. Put the Mystery bag on your lap.
- 4. Introduce: There are many objects in this bag. I am going to identify what they are without looking.
- 5. Hold the bag with one hand and with the other hand reach into the bag, choose an object, and feel it.
- 6. While feeling, visually show (make face expressions) that you are thinking (metacognition).
- 7. Identify the object before it comes out of the bag; and say: "It feels like a
- 8. Remove the object, place it to the left side of the table or rug, and say: "It is a
- 9. Keep going until done with all the objects in the bag (line them up to the right).
- 10. When done with all, ask your child the name of each object pointing to it.
 - a. Return to the bag the objects he recognized.
 - b. Keep the objects he doesn't recognize (do not put them back in the bag, and do not allow your child see you keeping it separate).
 - 11. Now tell your child: It's your turn to do it; suggest to put the bag on lap.
 - 12. Let him doing it by himself, fade and observe.
 - 13. You may put back the objects after he puts the Mystery Bag back to the shelf.

Language:

- Give the names of the objects in the bag well before working with them.
- Offer a Three Period Lesson with the objects the child couldn't name.

Notes:

- Change out the objects from time to time to renew the interest.
- Keep the bag on the lap to prevent from interfering with objects on the table.
