Parent Instructions - Counting 11-19 with Beads

Materials: A container

Colored Beads 1 - 9 (Short Bead Stair)

9 Golden Bars of 10 Rug (or felt for the table)

Purposes: To introduce the quantities 11 - 19 with their names

To see the relationship of the numerals 1-9 to the numeral 10

Steps:

- 1. Invite the child for the presentation. Tell him that we will work with the Teens Beads, and show him the materials: the tray with the Colored Beads and the Golden beads. Have him bring it to the table or rug. You bring the felt.
- 2. Take from the tray the colored beads, one at a time: name it and count it. When counting put your index finger over each bead.
- 3. Invite the child to build the Colored Beads Stair; count and place them in order from 1 to 9, top to bottom, one under the others horizontally.
- 4. Then, place a ten on the table and ask the child, what is this? Have him count it and place it vertically under the stair.
- 5. Take a ten, place a unit (red bead) at the top right of the ten; count the golden beads down to 10 and finish with the unit bead: "eleven". Say "ten and one make eleven".
- 6. Place another ten to the right, add two, count "ten and two", count and say "ten and two make twelve".
- 7. Continue in the same way to make thirteen.
- 8. Do a Three Period Lesson (including counting)
- 9. If your child shows interest, invite him to do three more (14-16).
- 10. In another day continue with three or six more.

Notes:

• Get in the habit to make lots of counting throughout the course of the day. Count steps, pennies, toys, Legos, cars, rocks, grains...
