## Parent Instructions Puzzle Map of United States Lesson - Printable

**Materials**: A flat map, with the political division (states) of the country cut out as puzzle

pieces.

**Purposes:** Visual recognition of the political divisions within the country

To help the child acquire the names of the states

### **Steps:**

1. Bring a rug and the Country Map (United States of America).

- 2. You bring the piece of the country from the Continents map, to reference back known knowledge. Compare them. Check some lands and water that are similar.
- 3. Take out some pieces.
- 4. Put the pieces back in the puzzle.
- 5. Invite the child to take of some pieces too; and then put them back.
- 6. Tell him that on this map we live just like here.
- 7. Transfer the work to the child.
- 8. Fade and observe.

Language: Names of all the states (next page)

#### **Notes:**

- Give this lesson after the child has learned the countries of North America.
- Introduce by Three Period Lesson the countries as soon as the child has confidence in building the puzzle. Remember to do three at a time, noncontiguous states, and add three more if he is successful and interested on going on.
- When a child takes out all the pieces of the puzzles and is unable to put them back in it is okay to sit and help. You can help him to identify the outer pieces first or help him sort certain regions of the map.
- See the control and blank maps for coloring, pin-punching, and identifying states.
