Parents Instructions – Colored Bead Stair

Materials: A container

Colored Beads 1 - 9 (Short Bead Stair)

1 Golden Bar of 10

Rug (or gray felt for the table)

Purposes: To introduce the colored beads and golden bead to count quantities 1- 10

Steps:

- 1. Take from the container the colored beads, one at a time: name it, feel it, sit it on the table and invite your child to feel it.
- 2. Invite the child to count it and then place one under the others horizontally.
- 3. Model how to build the stair and then invite your child to continue when he gets the pattern (after three or four).
- 4. When done tell him that this is the Colored Bead Stair.
- 5. Last, place one ten on the table and ask the child: Do you know how do we call this bar? If he doesn't know invite him to count each bead and say this is ten. Place it under the stair.

Notes:

- When counting put your index finger on right side of each bead.
- You may play the Three-Period lesson, taking three bars at a time so that your child associates name, quantity and color.
